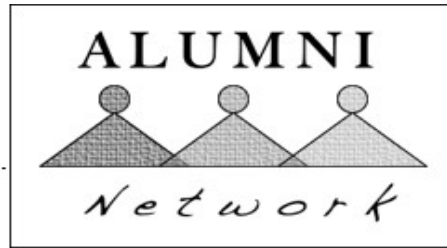

Sharing Photos
