CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

The biggest city in South America and one of the three largest in the world, Sao Paulo is considered one of Latin America's most important industrial and financial centers. It is the industrial center of Brazil, responsible for over 30% of Brazil's annual GNP and headquarters to the majority of Brazilian and multinational corporations. Strong industrial development and cultural diversity have provided Sao Paulo with the largest, most cultured and educated middle class in Brazil.

Sao Paulo can be an intimidating place, but if you like big cities, it offers the excitement and nightlife of one of the world's most dynamic. Attractions include the baroque Teatro Municipal, Niemeyer's Edifício Copan, the Museu de Arte de Sao Paulo (MASP) and the 16th century Patío do Colégio.

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

STUDY PROGRAM

The study portion of the program includes 20 hours per week of Group Portuguese classes with a 1 week minimum. Maximum number of students per class is 5, with the average being 2 students. Groups are organized in a way that each will always consist of students possessing the same level of Portuguese.

All of our teachers are native speakers with university educations and are very experienced teaching Portuguese to foreigners. Most have learned a second language themselves and understand the student's perspective.

The method is based on the 4 language skills: listening, grammar, oral and written comprehension. No English will be used in class. Classes are 45 minutes in length.

PHOTOGRAPHY PROGRAM

The NRCSA center in Sao Paulo, offers its students a 10% discount on photography courses at a local professional photography school. Immersed in the local culture and world of photography, against the urban landscape of Sao Paulo, students have ample opportunity for "hands-on" practice, both in the language and in photography.

Located in Sao Paulo's historic downtown, the photography school is a pioneer in Brazil in Digital Photography courses and known for its quality instruction for photographers of all skill levels.

Easily accessible by metro or bus, the school is steps away from a variety of photo subjects. Students are taught by talented instructors, proficient in their art, and experienced in working with foreign students.

The photography school's curriculum offers 7 modules, for students ranging from budding shutterbugs to more advanced enthusiasts and professionals. The first 3 modules are comprised of 24 class hours each. The final 4 modules, 12 hours each, are geared toward more advanced students, and teach specific techniques.

LODGING OPTIONS

HOST FAMILY

Live with a Brazilian family to experience the day-to-day lifestyle and practice Portuguese with your host family. Families are carefully selected, ensuring a clean and comfortable home, a single, private bedroom and convenient location to the school. Hot running water is available in most homestays.

2 meals daily (café da manha and jantar) are included in the homestay. Rice and beans are a dietary staple, as is fruit and meat. For lunch, there are many "self-service" restaurants with excellent food charged by the kilo.

Double rooms may only be booked by two students traveling together.

- Passeio das 9 ilhas: Boat ride along Lagoa Mundau, with stops to visit some of its islands.
- União dos Palmares: Visit to Quilombo dos Palmares, one of the biggest colonies of runaway slaves.
- Excursions are on the weekends, once every two weeks, in and around the cities of Maceio and Sao Paulo.
