PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This French & Cooking program enables you to combine a French course with cooking lessons. This unique program offers exciting hands-on cooking classes, meaningful cultural immersion, and an enriching language program.

CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

Cannes the "Star of the Riviera", sits on the Côte d'Azur in southeastern France, just southwest of Nice. The city's name became official in 1619 and was inspired by the rows of cane that once grew along its seashore. Cannes has been a resort spot since Roman times, and with summer temperature highs of 80F(27C) and winter temperatures no lower than 40F(4C), the city's popularity just keeps growing.

Cannes claims 69,000 permanent residents, but that number is surpassed dramatically during any one of their many festivals celebrated through out the year. Of course, the International Film Festival, first held in September 1946, draws the rich and famous, as well as the wannabe - close - to - someone - rich - and - famous crowds, but that's not the only thing happening in Cannes. Other festivals such as the Suquet Musical Nights, the International Festival of Pyrotechnical Art, the Yachting International Festival and the International Dance Festival are also popular in Cannes, as well as a vibrant nightclub and casino scene for visitors to check out.

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

STUDY PROGRAM

The study portion of the program includes 20 hours per week of Group French classes with a 2 week minimum. Maximum number of students per class is 5, with the average being 2 students. Groups are organized in a way that each will always consist of students possessing the same level of French.

All of our teachers are native speakers with university educations and are very experienced teaching French to foreigners. Most have learned a second language themselves and understand the student's perspective.

The method is based on the 4 language skills: listening, grammar, oral and written comprehension. No English will be used in class. Classes are 45 minutes in length.

Our program is divided into 6 levels of study. The first 4 are concentrated on grammar, vocabulary, practical situations, and conversation. The next 2 levels, advanced and superior, focus mainly on conversation and advanced reading and writing topics.

COOKING PROGRAM

If you're fond of French food, this program offers 2 week classes blending language classes and outdoor excursions so you can discover the culinary diversity of the region. This program, one focusing on French courses and main courses. In small classes no larger than 8, you will get to visit different French restaurants, as well as attend workshops to learn and develop techniques you'll have far after your visit.

LODGING OPTIONS

STUDENT RESIDENCES

We offer on-campus accommodation in the student residence. Each room is equipped with a washbasin. Showers and toilets are shared and available on each floor. Students should bring their own towels. Eighty-five percent of students choose to live on campus because it simplifies their commute to class and gives students the opportunity to get to know each other better.

HOMESTAYS

Homestays are organized in selected families who have received students from the school for many years. Students may choose a single or shared double room. Homestays include only bed and breakfast, but students who live with families may buy tickets to have meals at the college with the students living on campus. This option is available on request.

PRIVATE STUDIOS

Lodging in a private studio can be arranged, and is available on request at an additional cost.

ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES

U.S. citizens traveling with regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance of arrival.

Minimum age of 18 unless accompanied by an adult.

The school offers a full and varied program of cultural visits, sports, social outings and excursions through the year. Details vary from week to week and from season to season.
