PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Greek & Dance program enables you to combine a Greek course with the discovery of the world of dance. This unique program offers exciting hands-on dance classes, meaningful cultural immersion, and an enriching language program.



CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

Chania is located on the northwest coast of Crete. This is a picturesque city and walking through Chania means coming across Minoan remains as well as Byzantine, Venetian, Ottoman and Neoclassical landmarks left by the different civilizations which flourished on the island and have been kept alive in the traditions and customs of the inhabitants.

The Venetian harbor of Chania is lined with restaurants, taverns, cafeterias and ouzo bars. From there, the narrow streets of the city invites visitors to its mysteries and everything that is there to discover about Chania. The city is well known for its archaeological and historical museums, Venetian churches, Greek churches with old Byzantine frescoes, the Municipal Market, and the Halepa Quarter. All of these places are open for visitors and are a way to get exposed to Grecian culture past and present.

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

STUDY PROGRAM

The study portion of the program includes 20 hours per week of Group Greek classes with a 2 week minimum. Maximum number of students per class is 5, with the average being 2 students. Groups are organized in a way that each will always consist of students possessing the same level of Greek.

All of our teachers are native speakers with university educations and are very experienced teaching Greek to foreigners. Most have learned a second language themselves and understand the student's perspective.

The method is based on the 4 language skills: listening, grammar, oral and written comprehension. No English will be used in class. Classes are 45 minutes in length.

Our program is divided into 6 levels of study. The first 4 are concentrated on grammar, vocabulary, practical situations, and conversation. The next 2 levels, advanced and superior, focus mainly on conversation and advanced reading and writing topics.

DANCE PROGRAM

Dance is a fundamental way to understand a culture. In Athens, you will study several traditional Grecian dances. You learn the steps of the "Syrtaki" and other long-standing dances of the Zorba people. The dance classes are instructional and fun and consist of 3 classes per week. You can learn the steps of the "Syrtaki" that Zorba danced and have fun in the rhythm of "bouzouki.

The NRCSA center in Athens offers dance as a method to understanding language and getting cultural immersion. This enables students to use their knowledge of the language in day-to-day communication and in practice, all of this is done while having a great time dancing.

LODGING OPTIONS

HOMESTAY

The family will supply the student with his/her own room and the student shares meals at home two or three times a day, depending on what arrangement the student prefers. The living room and bathroom are shared with the other members of the family. The kitchen, though, is almost always reserved for the hostess, who prepares food for everyone. Students also have access to the terrace, patio, or balcony if the house has one. Laundry service once a week is included.

There are different types of host families that students may stay with: smoking and non-smoking, with children or teenagers at home, quieter families, vegetarians, with pets and without.

SHARED APARTMENT

Students may choose between an individual room or a double room shared with another student from the school. From four to six people live in each apartment. The kitchen, the living room, and the bathroom are shared.

Each apartment has one or two bathrooms, a living room, a fully equipped kitchen, and a washing machine (or access to one). Every room has a wardrobe or set of shelves, bed linen, and towels. Heating is available from September through June, and some have a television.

Cost of 2 weeks of classes, 6 dance lessons, and 2 weeks of housing ranges from:

ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES

U.S. citizens traveling with regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance of arrival.

Minimum age of 18 unless accompanied by an adult.
