Founded in 1158, Munich (München) has been the capital of Bavaria since 1503, and as far as the locals are concerned it may as well be the center of the universe. Münchener pride themselves on their special status; even people who have made Munich their home for most of their lives are still called Zugereiste (newcomers). Next to Berlin, Munich is Germany's most popular city, with everything you'd expect in a cosmopolitan capital. Yet it's small enough to be digestible in one visit, and it's got the added bonus of a great setting, with the mountains and Alpine lakes just an hour's drive away. The best time of year to come here is from June to early October, when the beer gardens, street cafés and bars are in full swing.

Munich has been able to preserve its unique charm which is expressed through its beautiful architecture with buildings from several eras and the typical lifestyle of its people: a mixture of tradition and receptiveness towards modern life. FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

STUDY PROGRAM

The Language & Dance Program revolves around a Standard 20 hour a week German language program. The basic formula for our language classes abroad is complete immersion, with focus on reading, writing, listening and speaking. The emphasis on these four areas helps to enable the student to use their knowledge of the language language in day-to-day communication. An immersion approach to the language is used for all levels - this means that from day one only the target language is spoken in the classroom.

DANCE PROGRAM

All levels are welcome to join our dance classes for a fun way to practice your language skills and improve your dance moves! You can choose between modern/contemporary dance, jazz dance and classical ballet.

Students take of 3 dance lessons per week at professional Iwanson Dance Center in Munich.

After German lessons in the morning participants take part in the dance lessons either in the afternoon or evening. Each dance class has a duration of 60 minutes. The Iwanson Dance Center is today the largest private dance studio in Europe and many professional dancers, now successful on the international stage, went to the Iwanson school.

LODGING OPTIONS

HOST FAMILY

Living in a German host family is the best and most interesting way to learn the German language and to get an insight into the German way of life. This is why most of our students prefer to be accommodated with families. The host may be a family with children, an older couple or a single person. Our student shares the bathroom and kitchen with their hosts.

SHARED APARTMENTS

Students are housed in shared apartments inhabited by one or more German. Each student has a single room in the apartment and you will share bathroom and kitchen; a good option if you'd like some service from your German host but don't want to be confined by having to integrate into their everyday life.

Student Apartments is a popular form of living among Germans, especially in bigger cities. You have a single room in an apartment you share with one or more Germans and take care of all meals yourself. The Germans are between 20 and 40, either students at Berlin universities or professionals. Often you develop close contacts with the Germans in your apartment.

ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES
