



# STUDY & INTERNSHIP PROGRAM MADRID, SPAIN PROGRAMS START EVERY MONDAY



## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This Study & Internship program combines a minimum 4 week Standard Group Spanish Study program followed up with a minimum 6 week Internship Work Experience placement in the community. All internship opportunities will work in partnership with local people in a variety of community-based projects. This unique program offers exciting hands-on work opportunities, meaningful cultural immersion, and an enriching language program.



## CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

The lady of Spain - Madrid. Spain's capital city thrives on an enchanting mixture of traditions and modernism. In this city of close to three and a half million people, one can find the Palacio Real where the crown jewels, antiques and priceless tapestries of the Royal Family are kept. The world renown museum, the Prado, displays works of such great Masters as Goya, El Greco, Velazquez among others. In addition to its traditions, Madrid is filled with "la movida"- a passion for the nightlife that fills the city until dawn.

## **FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

### **STUDY PROGRAM**

The study portion of the program includes 20 hours per week of Group Spanish classes with a 2 week minimum prior to internship. Maximum number of students per class is 5, with the average being 2 students. Groups are organized in a way that each will always consist of students possessing the same level of Spanish.

All of our teachers are native speakers with university educations who are very experienced at teaching Spanish to foreigners. Most have learned a second language themselves and understand the student's perspective.

The method is based on the 4 language skills: listening, grammar, oral and written comprehension. No English will be used in class.

Our program is divided into 6 levels of study. The first 4 are concentrated on grammar, vocabulary, practical situations, and conversation. The next 2 levels, advanced and superior, focus mainly on conversation and advanced reading and writing topics.

Students need at least an intermediate level of Spanish before continuing onto the internship portion of the program

### **INTERNSHIP PROGRAM**

After the minimum 4 week study program, there is a 6 week minimum internship placement in a business or organization in one of the following fields:

- Marketing
- International Business
- Hotels
- Advertising
- Law/Legal Studies
- Administration

## **LODGING OPTIONS**

### **HOMESTAY**

Two thirds of all students stay with families. These families have been carefully selected by the school. Most families are within 20-25 minutes walking distance to school. In the event that the homestay is farther away, students can use public transportation (subway or bus), the ride being approximately 12-15 minutes. Laundry is not included in family accommodations.

### **STUDENT APARTMENTS**

Those students who wish to take a one, two, or three month course in Madrid may be interested in renting a room in an apartment shared with other students. The rooms are furnished bedding is provided. The bathroom and kitchen are communal. Students should bring their own towels and are expected to pay for little expenses (gas, soap, etc.). Most of the apartments are 20 minutes away by public transportation. Keys will be given to the student upon arrival on the Sunday afternoon before classes begin.

## **PRICE RANGE**

Cost of minimum 4 weeks of classes, minimum of 6 weeks of internship placement and orientation, and minimum of 10 weeks total of housing is:

## **ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES**

U.S. citizens traveling with regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance of arrival.

Minimum age of 18 undergraduate, graduate students and adults with an undergraduate degree or higher are eligible. Intermediate level of Spanish before internship placement required. Internship positions on a space available basis. These are unpaid positions and there is a limited number of positions every month.

## **ACTIVITIES**

Every week, the school organizes cultural and social activities for the students to attend. Some of these are free and others at an additional cost. Examples include:

- Business Spanish
- Full day excursions to Toledo, Segovia and others
- Guided tours to famous Madrid museums
- Nightlife events
- Culture Classes
