PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This Study & Internship program combines a minimum 4 week Group Italian Study program followed up with a minimum 8 week Internship Work Experience placement in the community. All internship opportunities will work in partnership with local people in a variety of community-based projects. This unique program offers exciting hands-on work opportunities, meaningful cultural immersion, and an enriching language program.



CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

Milan is truly a city with something to offer every visitor. There are numerous famous monuments and historical attractions to admire, such as the Duomo, the huge gothic cathedral, La Scala and the Castello Sforzesco. A variety of architectural styles mixed with the works of world renowned painters, writers and musicians can all be enjoyed here. As an important cultural and financial center, Milan also offers a wide variety of entertainment, from opera to salsa dancing, from theatre to nightclubbing. Visitors will also enjoy Milan's glittering night life.

The city is also a fashion mecca and a capital of the industry. For serious shoppers or window shoppers, shopping is a part of Milan's culture, and the city's wide, tree-lined boulevards are home to the most elegant Italian and international fashion designer shops. Restaurants and bars cater to every taste, and antique enthusiasts can browse through the outdoor antique markets in the Brera and Navigli quarters. Sports and leisure facilities are also available throughout the city.

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

STUDY PROGRAM

Students participate in a standard 20 hour per week program. Groups are small with an average of 5 students per class and a maximum of 12. Levels vary from beginner to advanced. A pre-course interview and placement test are used to pinpoint the student's current level and tailor the course accordingly. Courses are usually designed to cover grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation, listening, speaking, reading and writing. The emphasis of the program is to encourage the student to communicate independently as quickly as possible.

The Intensive Group Program offers busy people with limited time the opportunity to improve their language at greater speed. After lessons, students can choose from a range of social and cultural activities in and around the city of Milan with a teacher. Students have two teachers on intensive courses to ensure that they encounter different accents and ways of speaking during their time in Milan.

INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

After the minimum 4 week study program, there is a 8 week minimum internship placement in a business or organization in Milan or the surrounding areas.

Students should indicate on their application form which sector or industry they are interested in working in (e.g. tourism, insurance, architecture, etc.). We will then do our best to find a position in a company working in each student's preferred field. Please note that the more specialized the request, the more difficult it is to find a suitable company. Similarly, if students are prepared to be flexible, finding a company willing to offer work experience will normally be relatively quick and straightforward.

LODGING OPTIONS

HOMESTAY

Homestay accommodation includes a single room with breakfast daily and use of the kitchen for other meals. For students traveling together or couples, a double room can be provided upon request. Host families that provide breakfast and the main meal on a daily basis are available at an additional cost. The school works with a limited number of host families, and booking is therefore subject to availability.

SHARED APARTMENT

For the independent student, single rooms in shared apartments are available as an alternative to the homestay accommodation. Bath and kitchen are shared. For students traveling together or couples, a double room can be provided upon request.

PRICE RANGE

Cost of minimum 4 weeks of classes, minimum of 8 weeks of internship placement and orientation, and minimum of 12 weeks total of housing ranges between:

ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES

U.S. citizens traveling with regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance of arrival.

Minimum age of 18 undergraduate, graduate students and adults with an undergraduate degree or higher are eligible. Prior experience or classes in the field of the internship placement and a Italian background (placement test to access level) are required. Internship positions on a space available basis. These are unpaid positions and there is a limited number of positions every month.

ACTIVITIES

The study center offers visits to near-by towns to highlight the practical, cultural, and social elements of the courses. These activities provide an excellent opportunity to relax and practice Italian with a member of our staff on hand. Activities often include:

- Outings to local sites such as the Sforza Castle and Brera Art Gallery
- Exhibitions (photography, contemporary art)
- Full day excursions on weekends
- Movie Club that meets every Wednesday
