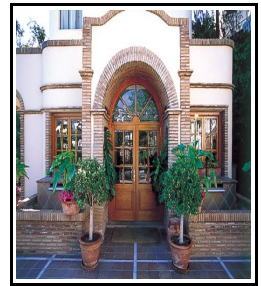




# SPANISH for MATURE ADULTS

### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This Spanish for Mature Adults program enables you to enjoy learning Spanish with other individuals above the age of 50. This tailored program offers exciting group lessons, meaningful cultural immersion, and an enriching language experience.



### CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

Malaga is the capital of the Costa del Sol, with a population of about 450,000. Its location, first-class tourist attractions, constant blue sky and Mediterranean Sea, warm hospitality, folklore, mild climate and wide variety of night sports and restaurants make Malaga an ideal setting for spending your time learning Spanish and enjoying yourself. Located at the heart of Andalucía, Málaga has excellent transportation connections with Granada, Seville, Córdoba etc. The Málaga International Airport is only 20 minutes drive from the school.

In Málaga you will learn pure Spanish (Castilian). The city also boasts excellent sports facilities: Golf, water sports, horse riding, skiing, hang-gliding, etc. Málaga is a totally Spanish City. You will eat pella and Gazpacho, you will drink Rioja and Sangria, listen to flamenco and Falla and Dance Sevillanas.

### HIGHLIGHTS OF PROGRAM

There are significant benefits to studying in a program that is designed specifically to fit the skill level and interests of the more mature age group. The courses will be held in Spanish, so language immersion is a core goal. Lessons will be in intimate groups with other students of the same age.

After participating in this Spanish program for Mature Adults in Malaga, students will greatly improve foreign language abilities, gain personal growth and confidence both nationally and internationally, and combine travel, academics, and passion for language into one incredible life-changing experience.

## **FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

### **STUDY PROGRAM**

The study portion of the program includes 20 Spanish group lessons per week with a 2 week minimum. Maximum number of students per class is 6. Groups are organized in a way that each will always consist of students possessing the same level of Spanish.

All of our teachers are native speakers with university educations and are very experienced teaching Spanish to foreigners. Most have learned a second language themselves and understand the student's perspective.

The method is based on the 4 language skills: listening, grammar, oral and written comprehension. No English will be used in class. Classes are 45 minutes in length.

### **MATURE ADULT PROGRAM**

This course is designed to provide individuals with the opportunity to study the Spanish language and experience the culture of Spain. You might be working alongside other individuals with a range of life-experiences that you can relate to, perhaps having already finished their professional career, maybe still working, or getting out for their first, or fiftieth, time abroad. It is not too late to have a cultural immersion that deeply resonates with you and all of your valuable previous life experience.

## **LODGING OPTIONS**

### **HOMESTAY**

For the serious student who is prepared to be flexible and wants to live a truly Spanish lifestyle during his/her stay in Malaga, staying with a host family can be the best option. Eat Spanish food, meet Spanish people and have the opportunity to practice newly acquired Spanish in real-life situations.

Some host families live in private houses with gardens, others in town houses or flats: most are within walking distance of the school and, if not, a maximum of 30 minutes travel. Host family accommodations are available on a half-board basis in single or twin rooms.

### **STUDENT RESIDENCE**

The school's student residence offers a range of options from fairly small singles to large executive rooms, all with en-suite facilities. Most rooms have direct-dial phones, most have balconies and the executive rooms also have double beds, fridge, bath (instead of shower) and a few nice surprises. The 24-hour reception allows the guests to come and go as they please with a high degree of security. There is a daily maid service.

### **APARTMENTS**

Share an apartment with up to 5 other students. Students can choose to have a single or twin room, the kitchen and other facilities are shared with the other students. Available on request.

### **EXECUTIVE APARTMENTS**

For students who would like an apartment for themselves or who would like something more luxurious, the school can rent other apartments. Whatever the length of stay the minimum rental period will always be a calendar month starting from the first day of the month. Available on request.

## **ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES**

U.S. citizens traveling with regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance of arrival.

## **ACTIVITIES**

The school offers a full and varied program of cultural visits, sports, social outings and excursions through the year. Details vary from week to week and from season to season.

Activities include:

- Visiting the Central Market to see, taste, and buy local fish, sea food, and fruit

- Local tourist visits

- Evening outings to cinemas
- Eating traditional Spanish meals and going out to eat
- Dance and salsa lessons
