PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This Spanish for Mature Adults program enables you to enjoy learning Spanish with other individuals above the age of 50. This tailored program offers exciting group lessons, meaningful cultural immersion, and an enriching language experience.

CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

Salamanca is host to the largest university in Spain. Its famous Plaza Mayor is the center of the city, with its sidewalk cafes, bars, and restaurants. Salamanca is a small town and it can be crossed on foot from end to end. Monumental churches, unique buildings, streets oozing with history... Salamanca offers all of this and much more.

Salamanca's climate is continental. Very dry, with cold winters, some freezing nights, and bearably warm summers. Salamanca is part of Old Castile and is located within a short distance from Segovia, Avila, Burgos, Santiago de Compostela, Leon, and Madrid, of course, which is just 200 kilometers away.

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

STUDY PROGRAM

This course is designed for mature adults, aged 50 and over, who, while improving their Spanish level, want to have a pleasant and cultural vacation. Lessons in the morning and cultural activities in the afternoon.

- 20 lessons per week, four per day, and every lesson lasts 45 minutes. From 9:00 am to 12:30 pm.
- 3 levels available: A2-Elementary, B1-Lower Intermediate, B2-Intermediate. Other levels (beginners, upper intermediate and advanced) will join the Intensive Course.
- 9 students maximum per group.
- Books and materials needed for the course are included in the price except dictionary.

The participants will be placed in classes according to the placement test.

MATURE ADULTS PROGRAM

This course is designed to provide individuals with the opportunity study the Spanish language and experience the culture of Spain. The courses will be held in Spanish and will be in intimate groups with other students of the same age.

NRCSA will organize cultural activities specially designed for the participants of the Mature Adult Program. Participants in the program can also join the general activities program of the school (culture lessons, visits to monuments, welcome party, etc) and they are expected to pay for this when needed.

LODGING OPTIONS

HOMESTAY

Homestays are with Spanish families. These families have been carefully selected and each one has been visited. Maximum of two students per family. Single room and the three main meals are included. Participants will receive a packed lunch with sandwiches and fruit on the excursion day. Double rooms are available for couples or friends coming together. It is very important to note any special dietary requirements on the registration form. Laundry (one load per week) is included. All families are within 10-25 minutes walking distance to the school.

STUDENT APARTMENTS

Those students who wish to take a one, two, or three month course in Salamanca, may be interested in renting a room in an apartment shared with other students. The rooms are furnished with bedding provided. The bathroom and kitchen are communal. Students should bring their own towels, and are expected to pay for little expenses (gas, soap, etc.). Most of the apartments are 20 minutes away by public transportation. Keys will be given to the student upon arrival on the Sunday afternoon before classes begin.

HOTELS

The Salamanca center suggests these hotel and apartment options which are situated close to the school:

- Hotel Salamanca Plaza. Includes a single room with breakfast daily.
- Hotel Conde David. Includes a single room with breakfast daily.
- Apartamentos D'Angelo. Furnished apartment, single room, no meals.

These options for hotels are available at additional cost.

ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES

U.S. citizens traveling with regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance of arrival.

ACTIVITIES

The school offers a full and varied program of cultural visits, sports, social outings and excursions through the year. Details vary from week to week and from season to season.

- Excursion to Alberca and Pena de Francia
- Weekend excursions each Saturday to a nearby town like Segovia or Zamora
