CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

Santa Ana is located on a hilltop about ten miles west of San José. Santa

Ana is the perfect location for those who are looking for a more rural setting, but don't want to give up access to the "big" city. The school has a lovely six-acre campus on a hillside near Santa Ana and is just ten miles west of San Jose. Additionally, Internet Cafes are located nearby, and can be used for a reasonable fee.

Santa Ana is a historic city with lots of museums and local history. It still has older small shops as well as more recent resetaurants and grocery stores. Santa Ana is surrounded by volcanoes and is close to various biological reserves.

HIGHLIGHTS OF PROGRAM

After participating in this Spanish program in Santa Ana, students will greatly improve foreign language abilities, gain personal growth and confidence both nationally and internationally, and combine travel, academics, and passion for language into one incredible life-changing experience.

There are significant benefits to studying in a program that is designed specifically to fit the skill level and interests of the more mature age group. The courses will be held in Spanish, so language immersion is the core goal. Lessons will be in intimate groups with other students of the same age.

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

STUDY PROGRAM

The study portion of the program includes 20 Spanish group lessons per week with a 2 week minimum. Maximum number of students per class is 8. Groups are organized in a way that each will always consist of students possessing the same level of Spanish.

All of our teachers are native speakers with university educations and are very experienced teaching Spanish to foreigners. Most have learned a second language themselves and understand the student's perspective.

The method is based on the 4 language skills: listening, grammar, oral and written comprehension. No English will be used in class. Classes are 45 minutes in length.

MATURE ADULT PROGRAM

This course is designed to provide individuals with the opportunity to study the Spanish language and experience the culture of Costa Rica.

You might be working alongside other individuals with a range of life-experiences that you can relate to, perhaps having already finished their professional career, maybe still working, or getting out for their first, or fiftieth, time abroad. It is not too late to have a cultural immersion that deeply resonates with you and all of your valuable previous life experience.

LODGING OPTIONS

HOMESTAY

You will placed with a Costa Rican family (one student or married couple per family) in the town of Santa Ana. The hosts will provide the participant with a private room, breakfast, dinner and laundry service. Lunch will be served to on the school's campus during weekdays

ALTERNATIVE LODGING

Two alternatives to lodging in a homestay are available in Santa Ana. The first is "La Casona", an attractive lodge with six bedrooms, each with a private bathroom. It also has a large dining room, two lounges, a reading/study area and kitchen. The second is "La Casita", a smaller lodge made up of two family suites, each with its own bathroom. There is also a shared kitchen and lounge. Both lodges have balconies with spectacular views overlooking the Santa Ana Valley.

<u>ELIGIBILITY AND</u> <u>GUIDELINES</u>

U.S. citizens traveling with regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance of arrival.

The school offers a full and varied program of cultural visits, sports, social outings and excursions through the year. Details vary from week to week and from season to season.
