PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This Executive Language program gives participants the opportunity to learn Spanish with native business practices, ethics, dialog, and mannerisms. The goal of this unique program is to deliver the knowledge and experience so participants can gain a competitive advantage in the international business world. In addition to learning in the classroom, participants will be exposed to local and regional businesses and will discover how business is conducted first-hand.



CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

Cordoba is the colonial capital city of Argentina with approximately one million inhabitants. It has the oldest and one of the most prestigious universities in the country, founded by the Jesuits in 1622, and the center of the city is rich in Spanish colonial architecture from the 16th century. Prior to the rise of Buenos Aires, Cordoba was Argentina's center of arts and learning, a place of scholars, priests, churches and universities.

Located in the geographical center of Argentina, the areas surrounding Cordoba offer opportunities for traditional and adventure tourism as the hills and valleys are filled with springs, crystal clear rivers, artificial lakes, and more. The Punilla Valley and Cuchi Corral have exceptional natural atmosphere for aerial activities, such as parachuting and ballooning, and on San Roque Lake windsurfing, yachting and all types of nautical sports draw people from all over. The Calamuchita Valley has lakes and clear rivers surrounded by mountains, an ideal area for swimming, mountain climbing and trekking, cycling, horse riding, fishing and other types of adventure tourism.

After participating in the Executive Language program in Cordoba, participants will return with an improved comprehension of the native language, a savvy understanding of how locals conduct business operations, knowledge of cultural and societal issues, and what to expect when managing international business.

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The goal of this program is to introduce students to the Argentinian work culture, providing the tools to develop communicative competences for general Spanish and also to acquire specific terminology applied to business.

This program includes 20 Spanish Group lessons plus 8 Group Business Terminology lessons per week. Spanish Group lessons typically meet twice in the morning, separated by a short coffee break. The afternoon is reserved for the Business terminology lessons. No more than 8 students per class. This class is open to elementary, beginner, intermediate, and advanced students.

Classes are 45-55 minutes in length depending on location. All non-beginner level classes will be taught entirely in Spanish (Immersion method). All teachers are native speakers with university educations and are experienced teaching Spanish to foreigners.

Other features that are included with this program include a guided orientation walk through the city and a variety of recreational activities.

LODGING OPTIONS

HOMESTAY

Students staying in a homestay will be able to practice their Spanish and be exposed to local culture. Middle class families are carefully selected and provide each student with a private room. Do not assume that you are too old for a homestay as many of our students are older than their host "parents". For many of our students, their homestay is one of the most rewarding experiences.

SHARED APARTMENTS

One of the most popular housing option is to live with other students in a shared apartment. The rooms are furnished (bedding provided) with a communal bathroom and kitchen. Cooperation with other students is necessary as the common areas are maintained only once per week. Most of the apartments are 10-20 minutes away by public transportation.

ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES

U.S. citizens traveling on regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance.

Minimum age of 18 unless accompanied by an adult.
