PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This Executive Language program gives participants the opportunity to learn Portuguese with native business practices, ethics, dialog, and mannerisms. In addition to learning in the classroom, participants will be exposed to local and regional businesses, and will discover how business is conducted first-hand.



CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

Nicknamed the city of the seven hills, Lisbon can be discovered by strolling along its esplanades lined with cafés, restaurants, and shops. You will be intrigued by the strange benches where the natives meet up to tell each other the most interesting or secret stories. The small maze-like streets go up and down frequently, offering constantly changing views of prestigious buildings from the era of the kings and navigators. In the evening, the Barrio Alto (the city's bohemian district) opens the doors of its designer bars and other traditional taverns where fado, the music of Cape Verde and Angola, can be heard, arousing even the most hidden passions of locals and visitors alike.

Lisbon is Portugal's capital, and home to almost 1 million people. The old and new rub shoulders in Lisbon: wide avenues of picturesque old districts, monuments, and museums intertwine together with modern skyscrapers. Eager for modernity, Lisbon's young people meet up on the docks, opposite the River Tagus and stay there until the early hours of the morning. Lisbon is a city which changes in atmosphere and color according to the light of day with inhabitants who give an innate sense of welcome and hospitality.

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

These courses enhance your language level, your spoken fluency, and your communicative skills in a business/professional context. Students will learn skills including taking part in meetings, speaking on the telephone, and writing briefings, business letters, and emails. Business courses are offered in combination with general courses. Classes are taught completely in Portuguese using the immersion method. This program is open to students of all speaking levels. Themes include but are not limited to:

- Banking
- Computer Science
- Hotel Industry
- Insurance
- Interpreting/Translation
- Law
- Medicine
- Marketing/PR
- Management

This program includes 30 hours of classes per week, divided into language classes and business classes. All teachers are professionally trained and have experience teaching to international students. The duration of this program is customizable, with a minimum enrollment of 1 week.

LODGING OPTIONS

HOMESTAY

Living with a local family encourages practice of the language and enriches the cultural knowledge of the student. Daily contact with the family enables you to practice the language regularly, as well as to explore the language, customs, and way of life of the country. This great experience is an excellent complement to the courses. Friendships are often forged and many students keep in touch with their host families long after their stay has ended. Host families are carefully chosen and are regularly monitored by student feedback. Your interests and hobbies will also be a factor in choosing the most suitable family for you. Most host families live near the school. Some families are able to take in more than 1 student at a time, and in these instances students who speak different native languages are generally paired together.

HOTEL

It is also possible to plan a stay in the comfort of a hotel room during your stay. Lisbon offers a wide range of hotels to choose from all over the city. Hotel accommodations are at an additional cost.

Cost of 1 week of Business Portuguese, lodging in a homestay, and registration fees is about:

ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES

U.S. citizens traveling on regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance.

Minimum age of 18 unless accompanied by an adult.

Additional activities include a wide array of orientation and cultural events. Students are accompanied by experienced guides who turn all of these activities into memorable experiences. Activities examples include:

- Introduction to various Portuguese Arts such as Ethnography and folklore, Painting, Ceramics, Jewelry Making, Sculpture, Photography.
- Outings to theaters, cinemas, concerts, wine bars.
- Lectures and debates on various aspects of life and culture in Portugal.
- Sports, water sports, and beach activities.
- Full-day and half-day excursions to local and regional points of interest.
