



# EXECUTIVE PROGRAM PARIS, FRANCE

## PROGRAMS START EVERY MONDAY



### **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

This Executive Language program gives participants the opportunity to learn French with native business practices, ethics, dialog, and mannerisms. The goal of this unique program is to deliver the knowledge and experience so participants can gain a competitive advantage in the international business world. In addition to learning in the classroom, participants will be exposed to local and regional businesses, and will discover how business is conducted first-hand.



### **CITY AND COUNTRY INFO**

What more can be said of Paris that has not already been said? Inviting promenades lead to the Esplanade of Les Invalides and the Champs de Mars which separates the Eiffel Tower from the Ecole Militaire. While here you should also visit the Botanical Gardens and the pedestrian byways around St. Severin. The Hotel Cluny Museum houses the famous tapestries of the lady of the Unicorn and you can then go along the Boulevard St. Michel (Boul-Mich) to the Pantheon, St. Etienne-du-Mont and to Francois Mansart's Val-de-Grance. Stroll through the Luxembourg Gardens where the Palace, built by Queen Marie de Medici, now houses the Senate. Writers and artists meet outside the famous Cafe de Flore and the Deux Magots while, to the west, Napoleon lies at rest at the Hotel des Invalides.

Students should allow plenty of time to see Paris. It is much easier to take things at an easy pace and, if you stroll slowly through the little streets and along the broad avenues, you will be able to appreciate to the fullest, all the charms of the city and her many riches.

### **HIGHLIGHTS OF PROGRAM**

After participating in the Executive Language program in Paris, participants will return with an improved comprehension of the native language, a savvy understanding of how locals conduct business operations, knowledge of cultural and societal issues, and what to expect when managing international business.

## **FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

This program is ideal for executives, business people and diplomats who need to acquire a high command of the specialized French used in their field in the shortest possible time. This course is also recommended to students or professionals who need to prepare for an important event: exam, professional meeting, conference, etc. Business people, managers, executives, business school students, and professionals from all walks of life would benefit from this program. The program is developed by specialists and based on student requirements and linguistic ability.

There are multiple course options available to best suit the different needs of participants, and are open to any level of speaker from Beginner to Advanced. Students may enroll in this program for as many weeks as they choose (minimum 1 week). Programs include:

- Executive Program: 40 one on one 45-minute lessons per week
- Manager Program: 20 one on one 45-minute lessons per week
- Business French for Mini groups: 26 45-minute lessons per week with no more than 14 students per class
- French and Law Program: 46 45-minute lessons per week with no more than 14 students per class; topics chosen to suit students' backgrounds

## **LODGING OPTIONS**

### **HOMESTAY**

The school selects a network of quality host families to allow students to gain the maximum benefit from their stay. You will have the chance to share meals with your host family, giving you the chance to practice your French and adapt to daily life in France with greater ease and pleasure. You will have your own room and all the families live close to the city center, at a maximum of 30 minutes by train from the school.

### **STUDENT RESIDENCE**

The student residence option allows you to stay in the heart of the city in one of the apartments of the hotel residence Appart'City. You will be able to live in one of the 84 studios, equipped with a microwave, hotplates, a refrigerator, an electric coffee maker and pots and pans. Each studio also has with a stowaway bed, a table, a desk with chairs, a TV, a telephone, a shower, a kit of sheets and towels, and a toilet. The residence includes access for people with reduced mobility. A fax/photocopying machine is located at the reception. Internet access and breakfast are at an additional cost.

## **ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES**

U.S. citizens traveling on regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance.

Minimum age of 18 unless accompanied by an adult.

Optional guided tours in and around Paris are available, as well as coached excursions to various chateaus around Paris. Students can also visit the many famous monuments including:

- The Louvre museum
- Notre-Dame
- The Eiffel Tower
- The Arc de Triomphe.
- The Marais
- The Ile St-Louis
- The Latin Quarter

Other activities included with each program include convivial Monday breakfast; intercultural evenings on a particular theme (ex. wine and cheese tasting), exhibitions by French painters, sculptors and photographers, and a farewell aperitif at the end of the course
