PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This Executive Language program gives participants the opportunity to learn French with native business practices, ethics, dialog, and mannerisms. The goal of this unique program is to deliver the knowledge and experience so participants can gain a competitive advantage in the international business world. In addition to learning in the classroom, participants will be exposed to local and regional businesses, and will discover how business is conducted first-hand.



CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

What more can be said of Paris that has not already been said? Inviting promenades lead to the Esplanade of Les Invalides and the Champs de Mars which separates the Eiffel Tower from the Ecole Militaire. While here you should also visit the Botanical Gardens and the pedestrian byways around St. Severin. The Hotel Cluny Museum houses the famous tapestries of the lady of the Unicorn and you can then go along the Boulevard St. Michel (Boul-Mich) to the Pantheon, St. Etienne-du-Mont and to Francois Mansart's Val-de-Grance. Stroll through the Luxembourg Gardens where the Palace, built by Queen Marie de Medici, now houses the Senate. Writers and artists meet outside the famous Cafe de Flore and the Deux Magots while, to the west, Napoleon lies at rest at the Hotel des Invalides.

Students should allow plenty of time to see Paris. It is much easier to take things at an easy pace and, if you stroll slowly through the little streets and along the broad avenues, you will be able to appreciate to the fullest, all the charms of the city and her many riches.

HIGHLIGHTS OF PROGRAM

After participating in the Executive Language program in Paris, participants will return with an improved comprehension of the native language, a savvy understanding of how locals conduct business operations, knowledge of cultural and societal issues, and what to expect when managing international business.

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

These programs are specially designed for professionals who need to communicate effectively in French in their line of work. They are tailored to their individual needs by focusing on a specific area related to their job and sector of activity. Specialized French can also be offered on a one-on-one basis. Professional fields most commonly taught include:

- Business
- Legal
- Medical
- Tourism
- Diplomacy
- Banking/Insurance

If your sector of activity is not mentioned above, a customized program can be developed as well, ensuring that your needs will be met.

These courses are intended for non-beginners; intermediate to advanced speakers only. Course schedules vary by program selected, but will include a mix of one-on-one lessons and small group lessons of 3-6 people. All programs will have around 25 hours of classes per week-15 group and 10 private. The duration of this program is customizable, with a minimum enrollment length of 1 week.

LODGING OPTIONS

HOMESTAY

Students will receive a warm welcome from Parisian families carefully chosen by the housing coordinators. Host families are eager to impart the French language and culture on the students they host. Additionally, host families enjoy learning about the culture of the student they take in and are eager to strike up conversations with participants. Host families provide breakfast daily. The option to receive two meals daily is also available, but at an additional cost.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

We can provide students with carefully selected, pleasant hotels that are all located near the school. Additionally, hotel arrangements can be made for students wishing to stay in another quarter of the city. All hotel lodging is available at an additional cost, and varies depending on location.

PRICE RANGE

Cost of 1 week of French Business classes (15 Group + 10 Private), lodging, and registration fees ranges between:

ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES

U.S. citizens traveling on regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance.

Minimum age of 18 unless accompanied by an adult.

ACTIVITIES AND EXCURSIONS

Optional guided tours in and around Paris are available, as well as coached excursions to various chateaus around Paris. Students can also visit the many famous monuments including:

- The Louvre museum
- Notre-Dame
- The Eiffel Tower
- The Arc de Triomphe.
- The Marais
- The Ile St-Louis
- The Latin Quarter

Other activities included with each program include convivial Monday breakfast; intercultural evenings on a particular theme (ex. wine and cheese tasting), exhibitions by French painters, sculptors and photographers, and a farewell aperitif at the end of the course.
