PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This Executive Language program gives participants the opportunity to learn Spanish with native business practices, ethics, dialog, and mannerisms. The goal of this unique program is to deliver the knowledge and experience so participants can gain a competitive advantage in the international business world. In addition to learning in the classroom, participants will be exposed to local and regional businesses, and will discover how business is conducted first-hand.



CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

Querétaro is located in the heart of México, approximately 125 miles north of one of the world's largest cities, México City. Besides being one of the largest industrial and business centers of modern México, Querétaro is rich in history and colonial architecture. The downtown of the city has been declared a Cultural Heritage of Mankind site by UNESCO. It offers the tradition of 460 years of history printed on its aqueduct, temples, and the large ancient colonial houses that make this city one of the most beautiful colonial places in México.

Some of the most important events of the Mexican Independence movement took place in this city around 1810, and was the home for many important figures who now form part of the country's history. Querétaro offers art and a variety of cultural events, as well as many recreational activities such as football, golfing, fishing, bullfights, horse back riding, camping and swimming. It has Spring-like weather the entire year, and is also one of the safest and cleanest cities in the country and only a few hours away from other colonial cities such as Guanajuato and San Miguel de Allende, a major center for Mexican and international art.

After participating in the Executive Language program in Queretaro, participants will return with an improved comprehension of the native language, a savvy understanding of how locals conduct business operations, knowledge of cultural and societal issues, and what to expect when managing international business.

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The goal of these programs is to teach students Spanish for business purposes. Classes have a maximum of 5 students each and are taught by instructors who have experience teaching international students. This is a unique program and offers several scheduling options:

- Executive Program: meets for 3 hours of group lessons plus 2 private lessons per day.
- Executive Intensive Program: meets for 5 hours of group lessons plus 2 private lessons per day.
- Private Lesson Program: Students may choose the amount of days or hours and customize their own schedule.
- International Bilingual Business Program: 6-week program that includes 6 hours of group lessons plus 2 private lessons per day. This program is intended for high-intermediate Spanish speakers.

The duration of all programs, except International Bilingual Business Program, is customizable, with a minimum enrollment length of 1 week.

LODGING OPTIONS

HOMESTAY

One of the best ways to learn Spanish is to live with a Mexican family. This provides multiple opportunities to learn new words and expressions, and it gives insight into daily life in México. It is an enriching cultural experience that opens many doors and it is long remembered. A number of families have been carefully selected to provide security and a comfortable atmosphere for students. All homes are less than 15 minutes from the school by car. Lodging includes a single room with breakfast and the main meal of the day served daily Monday through Saturday. Shared twin rooms are available upon request and if 2 individuals are traveling together.

HOTEL/APARTMENT ACCOMMODATIONS

If a student does not wish to stay with a family, there is a variety of hotels and inns in the city. The school will provide information and help the students find the one most appropriate for his/her needs. This option is available upon request and at additional cost.

There are also several furnished apartments for rent, from a flat to a several bedroom apartment. Please advise well in advance as these options are subject to availability. This option is available upon request and at additional cost.

ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES
