

EXECUTIVE PROGRAM REGENSBURG, GERMANY PROGRAMS START EVERY MONDAY



PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This Executive Language program gives participants the opportunity to learn German with native business practices, ethics, dialog, and mannerisms. The goal of this unique program is to deliver the knowledge and experience so participants can gain a competitive advantage in the international business world. In addition to learning in the classroom, participants will be exposed to local and regional businesses, and will discover how business is conducted first-hand.



CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

Located in Bavaria about halfway between Munich and Nuremberg, Regensburg is a gorgeous German city that has been able to retain a medieval atmosphere in its streets and buildings. Of special interest in the old city is the Stone Bridge that was built in the 12th century, and the Palace of the Dukes of Thurn and Taxis. Regensburg is also home to one of the world's most famous Boys Choir. The school is located in the historic center of Regensburg, which provides easy access to the many attractions of the old city.

The best view of Regensburg's medieval skyline is from the twelfth-century Steinerne Brücke, which was the only fortified crossing along the entire length of the Danube at the time it was built, thus giving it tremendous value for the city as a trading center. Concerts and plays are held in the courtyard of the nearby Thon-Dittmer Palais, one of the main cultural venues which comes alive with activity during the summer. A few minutes' walk away, the Neupfarrplatz is the center of Regensburg's commercial life.

HIGHLIGHTS OF PROGRAM

After participating in the Executive Language program in Regensburg, participants will return with an improved comprehension of the native language, a savvy understanding of how locals conduct business operations, knowledge of cultural and societal issues, and what to expect when managing international business.

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This tailor-made German course for professionals is ideal for those wishing to improve their German for business or academic purposes. The purpose of this program is to help students with grammar, vocabulary, phonetics, presentations, correspondence, phone calls, and other knowledge that will help in the business world. Participants can set the duration of the course length if they choose to stay in the program for longer than 1 week.

Classes include 20 group lessons in the morning, and 5 individual one-on-one sessions in the afternoon per week. Group sizes are comprised of fewer than 10 international students. One-on-one only programs are also available if the student wishes to maximize time spent with a teacher. Classes are 45 minutes each, with the number of classes per week depending on the topic chosen. Participants can select from several topics to focus on, including but not limited to:

- General language training
- Business German
- Exam preparation
- Translation
- Hotel & Tourism
- Medical German

LODGING OPTIONS

HOMESTAY

To ensure that students feel at home and relaxed in Regensburg, we take great care in choosing host families that are very friendly, knowledgeable, and outgoing. Living with a host family during the program offers participants the advantage to practice and converse with native German speakers away from the classroom, in real life and cultural settings. All host families reside within a few miles of the school.

STUDENT RESIDENCE

Students have their choice of a single or double room in the residence, which has shared cooking facilities and bathrooms. Additionally, students may use the university canteen where both midday and evening meals are very reasonably priced. The student residences are a good place to meet and mingle with other international students. Residences are located in residential areas and are within 20 minutes of the school by bus or bike.

ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES

U.S. citizens traveling on regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance.

Minimum age of 18 unless accompanied by an adult.
