PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This Executive Language program gives participants the opportunity to learn Spanish with native business practices, ethics, dialog, and mannerisms. The goal of this unique program is to deliver the knowledge and experience so participants can gain a competitive advantage in the international business world. In addition to learning in the classroom, participants will be exposed to local and regional businesses, and will discover how business is conducted first-hand.

CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

Sevilla, with its 700,000 inhabitants and more than 3,000 hours of sun a year, is said to be the most beautiful city in Spain. The city keeps alive the most famous Spanish customs: a vibrant street-life, flamenco music and dancing, bullfighting, and Holy Week (Semana Santa), as well as the openness, pride and warmth of its people. A blend of color and contrasts and joining the modern with the traditional, Sevilla offers a wide range of culture all year round which will appeal to all tastes.

Just ten minutes' walk to the east of the cathedral and center lies the Plaza de España and adjoining María Luisa Park, an ideal place to spend the middle part of the day. En route you pass by the Fábrica de Tabacos, the old tobacco factory that was the setting for Bizet's famed opera *Carmen*. Nowadays it's part of the university. Towards the end of the María Luisa Park, the grandest surviving pavilions from the 1929 Fair of the Americas have been adapted as museums. The furthest contains the city's archeology collections and opposite is the Popular Arts Museum, with interesting displays relating to the April feria.

HIGHLIGHTS OF PROGRAM

After participating in the Executive Language program in Sevilla, participants will return with an improved comprehension of the native language, a savvy understanding of how locals conduct business operations, knowledge of cultural and societal issues, and what to expect when managing international business.

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Designed specifically for business/professional students, this program aims to improve business presentations, specific business vocabulary, verbal negotiation, socioeconomic knowledge, and Spanish for trade and technical purposes. Lessons are taught completely in Spanish using the immersion method to ensure students are exposed to the language as much as possible. This program is open to students of all speaking levels. This course ends with an exam from the Chamber of Commerce of Madrid.

This program includes 30 lessons per week. Every day combines 4 lessons of general language with 2 lessons of business Spanish. Class sizes range from 6-10 students. Daily class schedules run from approximately 9 AM – 3 PM. All teachers are professionally trained and have experience teaching Spanish to international students. The duration of this program is 4 weeks.

LODGING OPTIONS

HOMESTAY

Living with a Spanish family is the best way for students to learn the language and experience Spanish culture firsthand. This option is recommended for all students, but especially younger students. Most students eat breakfast and lunch with the family and in this way have a direct and natural experience of Spanish life. All students are welcome to participate in this unique experience. Host families generally have teenage or older children. The school places students of different nationalities within any given homestay unless otherwise requested.

APARTMENT

This option involves sharing a flat with young Spaniards who work or study. The majority of these flats are in the historical center of the city and are within walking distance of the school. Rooms may be either single or double. There are usually one or two Spanish people living with one or two foreign students. With this option you can be both independent and in contact with Spanish people.

STUDENT RESIDENCE

Stately updated Sevillian houses are available in the heart of the city, with double and single rooms, TV rooms, kitchens, common bathrooms and terraces. This type of accommodation is recommended for students who desire independence and enjoy the international environment with fellow international students.

ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES

U.S. citizens traveling on regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance.

Minimum age of 18 unless accompanied by an adult.

After class activities are important, to facilitate both learning about Spain and meeting other students. The cultural activities schedule of 10 to 15 hours per week take place in the afternoon or evening and may include the following:
