The economic expansion that Shanghai is undergoing is one of the fastest the world has ever seen. Once a city caught in perpetual stagnation, the Shanghai skyline now contains more skyscrapers than New York City, with another two thousand giant buildings on the way.

This metropolis, located on the banks of the East China Sea, is now home to gleaming shopping malls, luxurious hotels and prestigious arts centers. The city is now ranked fifth by the Global Financial Centres Index, published by the City of London.

At 21 million residents, Shanghai is the sixth biggest city in the world! It was the first Chinese port open to Europeans and the birthplace of China's tourist industry. Today Shanghai offers amazing contrasts between traditional and futuristic and has a superb blend of Chinese and colonial European architectural style. Visitors will appreciate how the city has managed to retain its cultural identity and will enjoy the mixture of traditional & modern.

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Studying Chinese with the corporate program allows students the opportunity to learn business-focused content at a perfect pace. Through this program you will be able to master everyday situations, improve expressing yourself in business correspondence or in presentations, and work on special business vocabulary.

This program offers Elementary, Lower, Intermediate, and Upper skilled classes, and multiple levels per class. Group lessons meet 20 times per week for 50 minutes each, with a maximum of 5 students per class. Course schedules are flexible, with the focus tailored to your professional need. This program also allows you the chance to participate in an optional, unpaid internship, offering you real-world business experience.

LODGING OPTIONS

HOMESTAY

You will be able to experience everyday life firsthand, sharing meals and activities with your host family. You will have your own single room with a bed, desk, chair, and wardrobe. Bed linen, towels, and blankets are provided and access to shared equipped kitchen. Breakfast and dinner are included in the cost. You will need to share the bathroom with other members of the family.

STUDENT APARTMENT

Good quality apartments are available in a residence close to the school (5-10 minute walk). The students share a kitchen and bathroom. Towels and bed linen are provided and a cleaning lady visits on a weekly basis.

SERVICED APARTMENT

These apartments offer the same standard as 4 or 5 star hotel. In addition you get a kitchen, bed linen and towels are changed on a daily basis. We can reserve one in your name, but you pay the residence directly.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

3 star hotels, single (double bed) or twin-bed rooms are equipped with nice furniture, bathroom, kettle (or 24 hours hot and cold spring water), cups and jasmine teabags, hairdryer, satellite TV, fridge, telephone, air conditioning. A laundry service is also available at a very reasonable price. Most hotels also provide a business center where you can send and collect your email. Four and five star hotels have more facilities, some with swimming pool.

Cost of the 2 week semi-private executive program, lodging, and cultural activities ranges between:

ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES

U.S. citizens traveling on regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance.

Minimum age of 18 unless accompanied by an adult.

<u>ACTIVITIES AND</u> EXCURSIONS

Cultural activity program is offered each week but remains optional. Some are free, others range from \$6-\$12 each (average 65 RMB). Optional field trips including meals are usually under \$40 unless they include lodging). Here is a sample activity program:

Monday – Tai Chi

Tuesday – Chinese calligraphy or Chinese painting

Wednesday – Shanghai dialect

Thursday - Paper cutting

Friday – Dumplings making and tasting

Other: Chinese characters, Chinese medicine, Chinese cooking.
