PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This Executive Language program gives participants the opportunity to learn German with native business practices, ethics, dialog, and mannerisms. In addition to learning in the classroom, participants will be exposed to local and regional businesses, and will discover how business is conducted first-hand.

CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

The capital of Austria and home to 2 million residents, Vienna is situated on the banks of the Danube River. The influx of visitors from all over the world has made Vienna the most popular urban tourist destination in Austria. The city's location, not far from the splendors of Budapest and Prague, has made it a hotline to Eastern Europe, as well as a major center of modern business and cultural life.

Discover the glory and the splendor of Vienna, the city of art, culture and music; a safe and attractive place to learn German. Vienna is home to museums, exhibitions, theaters, concert halls and the world famous State Opera. Famous composers such as Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, Joseph Haydn, Ludwig van Beethoven and Franz Schubert made Vienna a city of music. Viennese coffee houses, bars and clubs also make a trip to Vienna an unforgettable experience. Annual festivals such as the Spring Festival (April), the Summer Film Festival (July, August) in front of Vienna's City Hall and the Vienna Festival (May) are famous all over the world.

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The combination of a standard course and business German enables you to learn everything you need for your job within a very short time.

This two-week program includes 35 lessons per week, including 20 Standard lessons, 10 Business German lessons, and 5 Cultural Programs. Class sizes range from 8-12 participants. This program is open to all levels from beginner to advanced.

Classes are 45-55 minutes in length. All non-beginner level classes will be taught entirely in the foreign language (Immersion method). All teachers are native speakers with university educations and are experienced teaching German to foreigners. To ensure maximum spoken communication, the classroom activities include intensive coaching in grammar, sentence structure, and vocabulary. Reading, listening, and writing form the basis for courses.

LODGING OPTIONS

HOMESTAY

Stay with a host family in their home. The host families offered by the school include lodging with young childless couples, others with children of school age, and older people whose children no longer live in the home. Accommodation in host families is definitely the best way to practice German while getting to know Austria - its people and culture, outside the classroom.

STUDENT RESIDENCE

Students who choose accommodation in a student residence have their own room. All residences are favorably located with rapid access to the city centre. Some have a kitchen where students may use the hotplates and refrigerator free of charge, however, students must provide their own crockery and utensils. Most rooms have a private bath and telephone. Shared rooms are also available on request.

STUDENT APARTMENTS

This type of accommodation is for those individuals who are very independent. Share a well-maintained apartment with other course participants. The use of common kitchen is included and the flat contains all the usual kitchen utensils and crockery. Single or double rooms with shared bathroom and kitchen. Most flats are also equipped with their own washing machine and TV.

ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES

U.S. citizens traveling on regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance.

Minimum age of 18 unless accompanied by an adult.
