PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This Italian & Diving Program enables you to combine an Italian course with diving lessons for a chance to have a complete cultural experience of a language and underwater beauty. This unique program offers exciting hands-on diving lessons, meaningful cultural immersion, and an enriching language program.

CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

Taormina is located high atop Mount Tauro, just above the Bay of Naxos. The magnificent Mediterranean blue bay and the not so distant, often smoldering Mount Etna offer a spectacular view which can be seen from almost any point in Taormina.

Of the possible destinations for studying the Italian language in Italy, Taormina represents one of the very few possibilities in Southern Italy, by the sea and in a beautiful town full of history and culture. Its celebrity is due to its beauty, its incredible history and architecture, and its reputation for welcoming travelers. Taormina is perfectly situated to offer students easy access to the beautiful and historically important treasures of Sicily.

The town of Taormina is also an important archaeological location. The first Greek Colony in Italy was established in its Bay of Naxos. And the town is also home to one of the most famous Greek Theaters in the world, where the main events of the summer Film, Music, Dance and Theater International Festival of "Taormina Arte" are held. There are also many more important monuments in town, from the Greek period to Roman, Byzantine, Arab, Norman, Spanish, French, Baroque, etc. With a strong vocation for tourism, Taormina offers many opportunities in the way of hotels, restaurants, bars, clubs, entertainment and sports (windsurfing, scuba diving, mountain-biking, canyoning, rafting, tennis and golf).

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

STUDY PROGRAM

The study portion of the program includes 20 hours per week of Group Italian classes with a 1 week minimum. Maximum number of students per class is 5, with the average being 2 students. Groups are organized in a way that each will always consist of students possessing the same level of Italian.

All of our teachers are native speakers with university educations and are very experienced teaching Italian to foreigners. Most have learned a second language themselves and understand the student's perspective.

The method is based on the 4 language skills: listening, grammar, oral and written comprehension. No English will be used in class. Classes are 45 minutes in length.

DIVING PROGRAM

This program is designed for those who know how to dive and want to experience the beauty of diving in Taormina. It is offered from May to October and includes 2 afternoons with 2 dives each afternoon.

Our Italian & Diving program provides a unique dive vacation which submerges participants in the Mediterranean Sea and its culture. Scuba-diving in the pristine, turquoise Mediterranean offers a diverse mixture of dive adventures guaranteed to excite the novice and to inspire the advanced divers:

- Diving in the exotic aquatic life in the Grotto Azzura in Taormina, Sicily
- Diving in the diversity of the Mediterranean Sea in Taormina, Sicily
- Diving to explore the archaeology of an ancient Roman wreck with its cargo of two thousand year old marble columns · diving and exploring the underwater locations of the film, "The Deep Blue."
- Wall dives teeming with striking white sponges and colorful coral
- Gentle beach dives from the shoreline

LODGING OPTIONS

SHARED APARTMENT

There are several apartments available throughout Taormina. All are privately owned and meet a standard level of quality. All are within a 15 minute walk from the school. Lodging includes a private room and use of bathroom and kitchen. Apartments are comfortably furnished with the basics, so as to be completely independent.

HOMESTAY

Students are provided with a private room and a choice of either breakfast or 2 meals daily while living with a host family. Availability of homestays in Taormina is very limited, so early registration for this lodging option is recommended. This option is at additional cost.

PENSION OR HOTELS

For those students who want total independence, accommodations in a 2 star pension with breakfast daily is available. This option is at additional cost. Three star hotels are also available upon request, and at an additional cost.

ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES

U.S. citizens traveling with regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance of arrival. Minimum age of 18 unless accompanied by an adult.
