CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

The smallest of the three major Bay Islands, Utila Island lies closest to the Honduran mainland, approximately 18 miles from the coast, and can be easily reached from La Ceiba either by sea or air. The tropical ferry operates Monday through Friday, leaving from La Ceiba's municipal dock and the trip takes only one hour.

The main town in Utila is known as East Harbour or simply Utila, and is located on the eastern side of the Island. Without question, the biggest attraction that Utila offers to its many tourists is its fantastic reefs combined with some of the least expensive dive courses in the world.

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

STUDY PROGRAM

This program consists of 20 hours of group Spanish lessons of 50 minutes each, 4 hrs a day, from Monday to Friday. The 20 hours of instructions include conversation, vocabulary, studies of grammar, reading comprehension, composition and a diploma upon completion.

DIVING PROGRAM

Utila boasts some of the best and least expensive diving on the entire Earth, especially if you are interested in seeing a whale shark, experience wall diving, or see over 95% of all Caribbean corals in one intellectual adventure.

Schedule: 4 hours daily in the morning, 4 days (2 full days and 2 half days)

Includes:

- * Theory: 5 chapters and examination.
- * All equipment included.
- * Water confined: 5 sessions
- * PADI certification included
- * Open water dives: 4 dives
- * All books: Crew pack (manual, log book, dive tables, stickers).

LODGING

HOTEL

A private room with a private bath, fan, cable TV, internet access, and hotel service. Meals not included.

Apartments

Small apartments are available. All rooms are air-conditioned and have ceiling fans, private bathroom with hot water shower, cable TV, refrigerator, coffee maker, microwave, and kitchenette with sink, crockery, and cutlery.

ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES

U.S. citizens traveling on regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance.
