PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Our intensive Portuguese for Educators program in Lisbon, Portugal combines the regular Portuguese immersion program with specific Portuguese and cultural training for educators. This is a great way to learn both general and specialized Portuguese. Educators at all levels benefit from this immersion experience.



CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

The Lisbon experience encompasses so many things, from enjoying a fresh pastry and bica (espresso) on a petite leafy plaza to window-shopping in elegant Chiado. It's mingling with Lisboêtas at a neighbourhood festival or watching the sunset from the old Moorish castle.

In the hilltop district of Bairro Alto, dozens of restaurants and bars line the narrow streets, with jazz, reggae, electronica and fado filling the air and revellers partying until dawn. Nightclubs scattered all over town make fine use of old spaces, whether on riverside docks or tucked away in 18th-century mansions.

As bright yellow trams wind their way through curvy tree-lined streets, Lisboêtas stroll through the old quarters, much as they've done for centuries. Village-life gossip in old Alfama is exchanged at the public baths or over fresh bread and wine at tiny patio restaurants as fadistas (proponents of fado, Portugal's traditional melancholic singing) perform in the background.

HIGHLIGHTS OF PROGRAM

In this Portuguese for Educators program, students will improve their communicative ability in both speaking and listening. They will discuss different methods of teaching with the instructors and the other students in the program, review grammar and other technical aspects of the language, and broaden their understanding of the culture and region of Lisbon.

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

STUDY PROGRAM

This course aims at teachers of Portuguese, whose native tongue is not Portuguese. If you teach Portuguese in your home country and want to update your language and teaching skills and discuss cultural topics, this course is perfect for you.

The course is an opportunity for you to update your language skills and exchange your experiences in using various teaching methods with international colleagues and teaching staff of the language school. Up-to-date information on Portuguese language and culture is part of the program. The course is designed to provide you with suggestions and new ideas which you can then put into practice after returning home.

The Study Program includes 30 hours per week of Group Portuguese classes for a minimum 2 weeks. Groups are organized in a way that each will always consist of students possessing the same level of Portuguese. The method is based on the 4 language skills: listening, grammar, oral and written comprehension. No English will be used in class.

LODGING OPTIONS

HOMESTAY

Private home accommodation is an important part of most students' stay. The NRCSA school's carefully selected homes will offer you much more than accommodation and breakfast - they will be your home away from home.

Living in a Portuguese home will help the student gain familiarity with the language. Students are placed in individual bedrooms and will be the only native speaker of their language in the house. The host may be a family or an individual. The homes that host students are in the area of the schools, many within walking distance. In case students need transportation it will never be more than 20 min.

Private home accommodation is usually booked from the day before starting lessons until the day after the end of the course (Sunday to Saturday). Private home accommodation does not include the use of the kitchen nor laundry of personal clothes. However students can ask the family directly for details of laundry services in the area of the house.

HOTEL

When students prefer not to stay with a family, the NRCSA school is happy to help find suitable hotel accommodation.

PRICE RANGE

Cost of minimum 2 weeks of Portuguese language classes, teacher training, culture classes, and housing is about:

ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES

U.S. citizens traveling on regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance.

Participants must have an intermediate level of Portuguese to participate in the Portuguese for Educators program.
