

SPANISH FOR EDUCATORS MALAGA, SPAIN PROGRAMS AVAILABLE IN JULY



PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Our intensive Spanish for Educators program in Malaga, Spain combines the standard Spanish immersion program with specific Spanish and cultural training for educators. This is a great way to learn both general and specialized Spanish. Educators at all levels benefit from this immersion experience.

CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

Malaga is the capital of the Costa del Sol, with a population of about

450,000. Its location, first-class tourist attractions, constant blue sky and Mediterranean Sea, warm hospitality, folklore, mild climate and wide variety of night sports and restaurants make Malaga an ideal setting for spending your time learning Spanish and enjoying yourself. Located at the heart of Andalucía, Málaga has excellent transportation connections with Granada, Seville, Córdoba etc. The Málaga International Airport is only 20 minutes drive from the school.

In Málaga you will learn pure Spanish (Castillian). The city also has excellent sports facilities: Golf, water sports, horse riding, skiing, hang-gliding, etc. Málaga is a totally Spanish City. You will eat pella and Gazpacho, you will drink Rioja and Sangria, listen to flamenco and Falla and Dance Sevillanas. The summer season lasts about eight months, from April through November, although in the remaining four months temperatures sometimes reach around 20 °C (68.0 °F).

<u>HIGHLIGHTS OF PROGRAM</u>

In this Spanish for Educators program, students will improve their communicative ability in both speaking and listening. They will discuss different methods of teaching with the instructors and the other students in the program, review grammar and other technical aspects of the language, and broaden their understanding of the culture and region of Malaga.

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

STUDY PROGRAM

This course aims at teachers of Spanish, whose native tongue is not Spanish. If you teach Spanish in your home country and want to update your language and teaching skills and discuss cultural topics, this course is perfect for you.

The course is an opportunity for you to update your language skills and exchange your experiences in using various teaching methods with international colleagues and teaching staff of the language school. Up-todate information on Spanish language and culture is part of the program. The course is designed to provide you with suggestions and new ideas which you can then put into practice after returning home.

The Study Program includes 20 lessons per week of advanced intensive Spanish classes and 10 lessons per week of teaching methodology, for a minimum 1 week. Maximum number of students per class is 10. Groups are organized in a way that each will always consist of students possessing the same level of Spanish. The method is based on the 4 language skills: listening, grammar, oral and written comprehension. No English will be used in class.

LODGING OPTIONS

HOMESTAY

Homestay allows you to experience the Spanish way of life and practice your Spanish with a Spanish family. You can choose between half-board, a single room, or a shared room. Homes are typically within 30 minutes travel from the school, by walking and/or by bus. Accommodation is from Sunday evening at the start of the course until the Saturday morning at the end.

STUDENT RESIDENCE

Triple, double, and single room options available. Triple rooms have 1 single and 1 set of bunk beds. Executive rooms have 1 double bed and are intended for individual clients or couples. Executive Studios can have 2 singles or 1 "king-size" bed. Three different meal plans are available: Continental breakfast, Half board, or Full board.

APARTMENT

Apartments feature shared bathroom(s), living room and kitchen. They are single or twin rooms, are self-catering, and can be shared with up to 6 other students. Two different types of apartment are available.

We have higher end apartments within 10 minutes walk of the school featuring air conditioning, higher levels of furnishing and facilities, access to a swimming pool, and a safe deposit box in each bedroom.

Our other apartments, ideal for the younger, long-stay student, feature easy access to public transport and shops/services, comfortable furnishings, and are within 30 minutes travel time to the school.

Cost of minimum 1 week of Spanish language classes, teacher training, culture classes, and housing ranges from:

<u>ELIGIBILITY AND</u> <u>GUIDELINES</u>

U.S. citizens traveling on regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance.

Participants must have an intermediate level of Spanish to participate in the Spanish for Educators program.
