### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Our intensive Italian for Educators program in Rome, Italy combines the standard Italian immersion program with specific Italian and cultural training for educators. This is a great way to learn both general and specialized Italian. Educators at all levels benefit from this immersion experience.

### **CITY AND COUNTRY INFO**

No other city comes close. It may no longer be caput mundi (capital of the world), but Rome is an epic, bubbling-over metropolis harboring lost empires.



One visit and you'll be hooked. Rome has a glorious monumentality that it wears without reverence. Its architectural heirlooms are buzzed around by car and Vespa as if they were no more than traffic islands.

The city bombards you with images: elderly ladies with dyed hair chatting in Trastevere; priests with cigars strolling the Imperial Forums; traffic jams around the Colosseum; plateloads of pasta in Piazza Navona; sinuous trees beside the Villa Borghese; barrages of pastel-coloured scooters revving up at traffic lights as if preparing for a race.

Here the national preoccupation with the aesthetic fuses with incredible urban scenery to make Rome a city where you feel cool just strolling through the streets, catching the sunlight on your face outside a café, or eating a long lunch. It's a place that almost encourages you to take things easy. Don't feel like going to a museum? What's the need when it's all outside on the streets?

### HIGHLIGHTS OF PROGRAM

In this Italian for Educators program, students will improve their communicative ability in both speaking and listening. They will discuss different methods of teaching with the instructors and the other students in the program, review grammar and other technical aspects of the language, and broaden their understanding of the culture and region of Rome.

### FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

#### STUDY PROGRAM

This course aims at teachers of Italian, whose native tongue is not Italian. If you teach Italian in your home country and want to update your language and teaching skills and discuss cultural topics, this course is perfect for you.

The course is an opportunity for you to update your language skills and exchange your experiences in using various teaching methods with international colleagues and teaching staff of the language school. Up-to-date information on Italian language and culture is part of the program. The course is designed to provide you with suggestions and new ideas which you can then put into practice after returning home.

The Study Program includes 54 lessons of theory plus 16 lessons of practical in class training over 2 weeks. The lessons are held in small group with minimum of 5 and maximum of 15 students. One lesson lasts 60 minutes. Groups are organized in a way that each will always consist of students possessing the same level of Italian. The method is based on the 4 language skills: listening, grammar, oral and written comprehension. No English will be used in class.

## **LODGING OPTIONS**

#### HOMESTAY

In selecting host families, we do not look for luxury and comfort in the material sense but for Italian families who appreciate hosting foreign students. These can be "traditional" with children, a single parent or a childless couple who take in students because they enjoy the company. You can choose between breakfast and half board (breakfast and dinner). You have your meals together with the family but you should be aware that Italian eating habits can be rather different from your own. Breakfast usually only consists of coffee or tea and bread, butter, marmalade. Dinner is a complete meal served normally at around 8:00 P.M.

#### SHARED APARTMENT

Living in an apartment, together with other foreign or Italian students or with the landlord/landlady, requires maturity but allows you considerable independence. You share the bathroom and the kitchen with roommate(s) and can cook on your own.

#### **PRIVATE APARTMENT**

Private apartments are more comfortable than shared apartments and therefore more expensive. They are available for one or more people. Prices are available on request. Please note that the private apartments must be reserved well in advance and the prices vary depending on the city and season.

#### STUDENT RESIDENCE

One, two and three-roomed apartments with either two, three or four beds in each; a lounge, a kitchen area, bathroom with shower, direct dial telephone, air conditioning, television and daily cleaning services. On request, there are normally the following supplementary services: parking, breakfast, secretarial services and a safe for valuables.

#### HOTEL

We work with hotels located close to the school (basic offer always: bed & breakfast, rooms with shower or bathroom). Prices are available on request.

### <u>ELIGIBILITY AND</u> <u>GUIDELINES</u>

U.S. citizens traveling on regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance.

Participants must have an intermediate level of Italian to participate in the Italian for Educators program.
