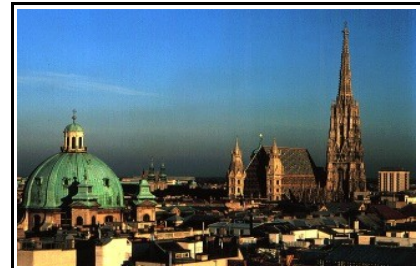

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Our intensive German for Educators program in Vienna, Austria combines the standard German immersion program with specific German and cultural training for educators. This is a great way to learn both general and specialized German. Educators at all levels benefit from this immersion experience.

CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

The capital of Austria and home to 2 million residents, Vienna is situated on the banks of the Danube. The influx of visitors from all over the world has made Vienna the most popular urban tourist destination in Austria. The city's location, not far from the splendors of Budapest and Prague, has made it a hotline to Eastern Europe, as well as a major center of modern business and cultural life. It is said that the most melodic German is spoken in the old city.

Vienna is a romantic, imperial city, with highlights including the magnificent Imperial Palace, majestic Schönbrunn Palace, and the magic of Ringstraße. What was once the heart of the Austro-Hungarian monarchy is now the stuff dreams are made of. Discover the glory and the splendor of Vienna, the city of art, culture and music; a safe and attractive place to learn German. Vienna is home to museums, exhibitions, theaters, concert halls and the world famous State Opera. Yet Viennese coffee houses, "Heuriger" - the name given by the Viennese to both the wine of the last harvest and the taverns where it is served - bars and clubs also make a trip to Vienna an unforgettable experience. Vienna's culinary diversity is also impressive. Delights such as semolina dumpling soup, tender boiled beef and apple strudel are typical Austrian dishes.

HIGHLIGHTS OF PROGRAM

In this German for Educators program, students will improve their communicative ability in both speaking and listening. They will discuss different methods of teaching with the instructors and the other students in the program, review grammar and other technical aspects of the language, and broaden their understanding of the culture and region of Vienna.

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

STUDY PROGRAM

This course aims at teachers of German, whose native tongue is not German. If you teach German in your home country and want to update your German and teaching skills and discuss cultural topics, this course is perfect for you.

The course is an opportunity for you to update your language skills and exchange your experiences in using various teaching methods with international colleagues and teaching staff of the language school. Up-to-date information on Austrian and German language, culture and literature is part of the program. The course is designed to provide you with suggestions and new ideas which you can then put into practice after returning home.

The Study Program includes 20 hours per week of Group German classes and 5 hours per week of cultural classes, for a minimum 2 weeks. Maximum number of students per class is 12, with a minimum of 8 students. Groups are organized in a way that each will always consist of students possessing the same level of German. The method is based on the 4 language skills: listening, grammar, oral and written comprehension. No English will be used in class.

LODGING OPTIONS

HOMESTAY

You stay with a host family in their own home. Accommodation in host families is definitely the best way of practicing your German and getting to know Austria and its people outside of the classroom. Host families can be childless couples, parents with schoolchildren or older people whose grown-up children have already left home. Homestay is available year-round. You may choose from use of the kitchen, substantial breakfast only or half board with a three-course lunch or evening meal. You have your own single or twin room. You share the bathroom and the kitchen with your host family.

APARTMENT

Available year-round. You are accommodated in a well-maintained flat, often shared with other students. The use of kitchen is included in the price. The flat contains all the usual utensils and crockery. Single or double rooms with shared bathroom and kitchen. Most flats are also equipped with their own washing machine and TV.

STUDENT APARTMENTS

Especially well-equipped standard or superior apartments with twin or single rooms with free W-LAN/WiFi in newly-renovated art deco building typical for Vienna!

Superior Apartments: Private bathroom and fully equipped kitchen, all amenities.

Standard Apartments: Shared bathroom and fully equipped shared kitchen, all amenities.

HOTEL

Our friendly guest house is located in a recently renovated Art Nouveau building close to the city center of Vienna. Enjoy the comforts of home and a great degree of independency and privacy in a quiet location. All our rooms are non-smoking.

ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES

U.S. citizens traveling on regular passports for tourism or business do not need a visa for a stay of 90 days or less. Those planning a longer visit must obtain a visa in advance.

Participants must have an intermediate level of German to participate in the German for Educators program.
