PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This Italian & Wine and Cooking program enables you to combine an Italian course with wine lessons. This unique program offers exciting hands-on wine classes, meaningful cultural immersion, and an enriching language program.

CITY AND COUNTRY INFO

Portico di Romagna and San Benedetto, a single community made up of three small centers, was originally, that is, in the Middle Ages, part of the Princedom of Tuscany.

From an administrative point of view, it is today part of Emilia Romagna. It has remained a picturesque and historical little town, situated in one of the many Appenine valleys between Tuscany and Emilia Romagna. Well restored medieval buildings, oak beams and narrow streets characterize the town. It is an interesting place which invites one to relax and to enjoy life outdoors. There are plenty of opportunities, as well, for outdoor activities and sports, such as trekking, riding and canoeing.

The `Romagnoli', as the city inhabitants are referred to, are amongst the most friendly and forthcoming of all Italians. You will find it easy to make contacts, and you will be pleasantly surprised by their unforgettable politeness, honesty and generosity. The town and the villages in the vicinity organize, all through the year, various different cultural events - the Harvest Festivals, for instance, to which you are, of course, invited. In the woods nearby one can go for beautiful walks and peacefully regain harmony with the world of nature. The remnants of the past, from the early Roman days to the Middle Age, will attract those with an eye for history.

Local specialties are truffles and wild mushrooms. Local wines of international repute are the red Sangiovese and the white Albana.

FULL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

STUDY PROGRAM

With this program students take language classes in the morning before their afternoon wine and cooking classes, which are combined for one week in this program. The maximum number of students per class is 5, with the average being 2 students, and the classes take place in the restaurant "Al Vecchio Convento". Groups are organized in a way that each will always consist of students possessing the same level of Italian.

All of our teachers are native speakers with university educations and are very experienced teaching Italian to foreigners. Most have learned a second language themselves and understand the student's perspective.

The method is based on the 4 language skills: listening, grammar, oral and written comprehension. No English will be used in class. Classes are 45 minutes in length.

WINE AND COOKING LESSONS

For one week, you will immerse yourself in the wine and cooking of Portico di Romagna. Combined with a cooking course, this class teaches you about the history and detail of the wines you drink, culminating at the end of the week with a visit to a winery. The class evenly divides cooking lessons with wine lessons as they compliment eachother so well. Students take language classes in the morning and the cooking and wine lessons in the afternoon.

LODGING OPTIONS

SCHOOL APARTMENT

The school staff arranges lodging in student aprtments located in a very quiet area, 5 minutes on foot from the language school. The apartments are plain and functional, with students being responsible for the cleaning of their own bedroom and of the shared spaces. There are single and double rooms available with a shared bath and kitchen. Bed linens are provided but students must bring their own towels.

HOTELS

Reservations can be made at the 3 star hotel "Al Vecchio Convento" with breakfast daily. The hotel is well known for it's food, and it is available upon request and at additional cost.

ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES
