## INTERNATIONAL LANGUAGE CENTER – MILAN, ITALY

### ABOUT THE SCHOOL AND THE CITY

**International Language Center** is a member of The World Organization which has affiliate schools in over 30 different countries worldwide. Standards are maintained through implementation of a rigorous code of practice and regular inspection. The International Language Center staff are all highly trained and experienced in language teaching to foreign students and pay particular attention to students' overall well-being during their stay in Milan. All classrooms are fully equipped with satellite, video and audio facilities. Video and lending libraries are also available.

Milan truly is a city with something to offer every visitor. There are numerous famous monuments and historical attractions to admire, such as the Duomo, the huge gothic cathedral, La Scala and the Castello Sforzesco. A variety of architectural styles and the works of world renowned painters, writers and musicians can all be enjoyed here. As an important cultural and financial centre, Milan also offers a wide variety of entertainment, from opera to salsa dancing, from theatre to night clubbing.

### ABOUT THE PROGRAM

A wide variety of courses for adults (18+) are available all year round. Groups are small with a maximum of 6 students per class and levels range from beginner to advanced. A pre-course interview and placement test helps the school to pinpoint the students' learning needs. Courses cover grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation, listening, speaking, reading and writing.

### Intensive Group Program

20 hours per week, 2 week minimum. Intensive Group Course offers busy people with limited time the opportunity to improve their language. After lessons, students can choose from a range of social and cultural activities in and around the city of Milan with a teacher. Students have two teachers on intensive courses to ensure that they encounter different accents and ways of speaking.

### Executive Program - Upper-Intermediate Level Required.

25 hours per week - 15 hours Group + 10 hours Tutor. This program is designed for those who want to improve their knowledge of Italian for use in a particular professional field. It combines 15 hours per week of study in a group setting and individual lessons with a private tutor for 10 hours per week. The private lessons focus on the following topics: Italian for Marketing; Italian for Finance; Telephone Italian; Presentations; Negotiating.

### Intensive Group & Cooking Program

20+ hours per week. This course combines Intensive Group classes of 20 hours per week in the morning with two afternoons per week of Italian Cooking Classes.

### Language & Culture Programs

International Language Center's Italian Language & Culture Programs provide students with further opportunities to increase their knowledge of different aspects of Italy and to socialize with other students and teachers. Culture classes are given by teachers with an interest in the topic.

### ACCOMMODATIONS

#### Homestays

Homestay accommodation includes a single room with breakfast daily and use of the kitchen for other meals. For students traveling together or couples, a double room can be provided. Because the International Language Center offers a limited number of host families, booking is therefore subject to availability.

#### Shared Apartments

For the independent student, the International Language Center offers single rooms in shared apartments. Bath and kitchen are shared. For students traveling together or couples, a double room can be provided.

#### Hotels, ApartHotels & Guest Houses

A list of hotels, apart-hotels and guest houses is available on request. Prices range from a daily fee of Lit. 25,000 (Euro 13) for a guest house to Lit. 250,000 (Euro 130) for a single room in a 3/4 star hotel.

### SPECIAL ACTIVITIES

The International Language Center offers visits to nearby towns to highlight the practical/cultural/social elements of the courses. These activities provide an excellent opportunity to relax and practice Italian.

The program of activities varies each month and is organized by the International Language Center's Italian courses coordinator and/or teachers. Cultural and social activities are optional and at additional cost. These include trips to museums, theatres, cinemas and weekend excursions.
