ABOUT THE SCHOOL AND THE CITY

Scuola Sorrento is located in a 16th century palazzo in the dramatic seaside town of Sorrento. The teachers are selected using the highest criteria to ensure that each student has a successful and gratifying learning experience. Each language instructor is required to pose a superior level of education, training, experience and skill. Each one has been trained and qualified to administer language certification under TELC, The European Language Certificates. Each instructor represents a multitude of ages, races, ethnicities and genders, providing each student with a diverse educational experience..

Sorrento, with its luxuriant vegetation and sun-drenched climate, became a favorite resort of wealthy Romans. A cliff-top setting, an imposing cathedral in the main piazza, a Franciscan church with a distinctive 13th-century cloister, and a charming, flower-filled town draws thousands of modern-day visitors as well.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Standard Program Group 20 hours per week. Consists of four hours per day of Italian language classes held five days per week, Monday through Friday. Classes are scheduled to begin at 9.00 each morning and end at 13.15 (1:15pm), with one fifteen minute break from 11.00 to 11.15. There is an average of 10-12 students per class.

Intensive Program Group 25 hours per week: 20 Italian Language + 5 Culture. The Intensive Program combines twenty hours of Italian language classes with five hours of cultural study per week. The cultural classes are held in the afternoon and themes are based on the particular interests of the participants. Themes could include topics related to Italian history, literature, current events, etc. that are designed to build a students' cultural language skills. There is an average of 10-12 students per class.

Super Intensive Program Group + Tutor 25 hours per week: 20 Group Italian Language + 5 Tutor. The Super Intensive Program combines the Basic Program of four hours per day of Italian language classes with one hour per day of individual Italian language classes, held five days per week, Monday through Friday.

Basic Language & Cooking Program 20 hours of Italian language + 3 lessons of Cooking per week. The Standard Language & Cooking Program combines twenty hours of group Italian language classes with three cooking lessons per week.

Basic Language & Voice Lessons Program 20 hours of Italian language + 10 Voice lessons of per week. The Standard Language & Voice Lessons Program combines twenty hours of group Italian language classes with ten voice lessons per week.

Basic Language & Ceramics Program 20 hours of Italian language + 10 Ceramics lessons of per week. The Standard Language & Ceramics Program combines twenty hours of group Italian language classes with ten ceramics classes per week.

Christmas Course 2 weeks, 24 hours Italian Language + Activities. This special 2 week course is designed for students that want to experience the year-end holidays Italian style. The course includes six days of formal Italian language classes held four hours per day in small groups averaging 10 to 12 students, as well as special dinners, a tour of the churches of Sorrento, a Christmas cooking class, an excursion to Naples, and a New Year's Eve dinner cooking class. Combine that with staying with a host family and you've got a perfect intercultural holiday experience.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Homestay Includes a single room with breakfast daily. Half board (breakfast and dinner) and double rooms for students traveling together can be arranged upon request and at additional cost. This is an excellent opportunity to practice Italian on a daily basis and sample the delights of Italian home cookery.

Shared Student Flat Rooms in shared student flats have shared bathroom and kitchen facilities. The number of rooms per flat varies from 1 to 7. Double rooms are for students traveling together only. This option is available at additional cost.

Independent Flat For the more independent student, we offer private flats. This option is available at additional cost.

Hotel There are a wide range of hotels, from one to five stars, in the city center and surrounding area. This option is available upon request and may be at additional cost.
